

Practical information and programme for the SEAFOODplus meetings, Open Conference and gala dinner 3, 4 and 5 October 2005 in Granville, France

SHUTTLE BUS SERVICE

DIFRES and IFREMER are bringing staff vans to Granville that will be used as shuttle busses from Sunday 2 October until Saturday 8 October (the service on 7 and 8 October are for those SEAFOODplus participants that also attend the Health Sea International Symposium 6-7 October).

The two busses will run between Granville train station and peoples hotels. They will be waiting for people at the train station when the trains from Paris arrive. There will be a SEAFOODplus sign in the window of the van and the two chauffeurs (Hugo Ladefoged from DIFRES and Christian Richard from IFREMER) will carry a SEAFOODplus sign themselves.

The SEAFOODplus vans will be at the participant's service at Granville train station Sunday, Monday, Tuesday at the following train arrival times:

Sunday: 16:43, 19:43, 22:45

Monday and Tuesday: 10:16, 13:29, 16:33, 19:39, 22:45

If you arrive by plane at Rennes airport or arrive at Rennes train station, then please e-mail Jette Donovan Jensen at jej@difres.dk in order to book the van to pick you up.

The travel back to Granville station, Rennes station or Rennes airport will be arranged when we have an overview of the need. In order to arrange this, please tell the driver when your anticipated departure will be.

There are three meeting venues during the 3, 4, and 5 October.

- (1) The City Hall 'Bazeilles, Rue du Roc
- (2) The Chambre de Commerce et d' Industry Centre et Sud Manche (CCI), Place Albert Godal
- (3) The Conference Centre Archipel, Place Mal Foch

The three locations are indicated at the attached map together with the two main hotels.

Monday 3 October: All activities will take place at (1) the City Hall, i.e. registration, meetings, lunch and a cocktail reception.

Tuesday 4 October: Meetings will take place both at (1) the City Hall and (2) CCI. Registration will take place at CCI only. Lunch and a 'walk-in-café' are taking place at (1) The City Hall.

Cars are not allowed to drive on Mont-Saint-Michel, so we will be walking up the hill to the Abbey. *People should wear good walking shoes for this exercise.*

At the abbey, which is a true marvel, it is the most splendid of all the abbeys in France, we will be welcomed with a cocktail in the dining room of the monks where a local guide will tell the history of the place (in both French and English).

The gala dinner will take place at a restaurant in front of Mont-Saint-Michel, which will be lit, so we have a splendid view of the Castle of Mont-Saint-Michel.

During the gala dinner, the award for the best presentation at the Open Conference will be revealed by the award jury.

The busses will transport people back from the restaurant to the Archipel.
