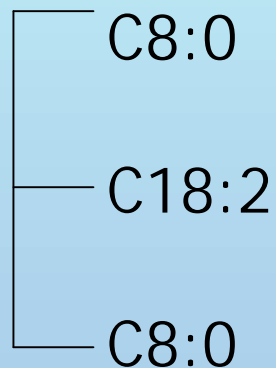




What are specific structured lipids (SL)

- Lipids with a predetermined fatty acid profile and a specific structure, e.g.:



- Produced by e.g. 1,3 specific lipase (Lipozyme RM IM)
- Purified by e.g. short path distillation to remove FFA



Structured lipids for clinical use and functional foods

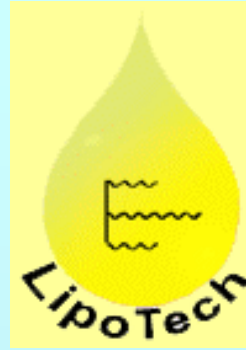
- ✍ High energy supplements with essential fatty acids for:
 - Patients with cystic fibrosis and short bowel disease
 - Patients recovering from burn wounds and operations
 - Pre-term infants

- ✍ Infant milk formulas

- ✍ Fats with CLA (antiatherogenic- and anticarcinogenic effects and regulatory effect on immune system)

- ✍ Low energy fats

- ✍ Effect on nitrogen balance (functional feed)
